Prerequisite: None. This day is designed to provide an understanding of ANSI/ISO/ASQ 9001:2015 quality management systems requirements for implementation. The training will examine the 10 specific clauses of the standard, Management's role, business operational processes tied to metrics (Key Performance Indicators, "KPI's"), the application of the "Risk Management Process" and a review of examples. A key aspect of the course presents methods to document your business management processes to meet the requirements of the standard. The course format is lecture, discussion, and learning feedback workshops.</p> <p>Day 2: Audit Mechanics-Process Based Audit Methodology. Prerequisite: Understanding the ISO 9001:2015 Standard Requirements. This day is designed to develop internal quality management systems auditing skills using the process approach. Attendees will use the understanding from Day 1 and apply that material to the auditing process. This day concentrates on the AS9100 revision "D" aerospace supplements to the requirements of the ISO 9001-2015 Standard. The application of AS9101 Requirements for Conducting Audits to AS9100D, and AS9104 Requirements for Certification to AS9100D. These requirements have changed resulting in a significant impact on your certification and certification process, whether Initial Certification, Surveillance, or Renewal assessments. How to interact with the new v3 OASIS database which is the method AS9100 Audits are conducted. Discussions include implementation strategies and a review of the "Most Common Nonconformities" encountered during certification, maintaining certification, or upgrading from ISO9001:2015 certification. Key points of focus covered are Containment, Risk, Direct Cause, Contributing Cause, Root Cause, Correction, Corrective Action, and effectiveness of actions taken. Description: This program is designed to provide an understanding of Management's role for the implementation of the Quality Management System baseline requirements of the ISO Series Standards, which provides the basis for many other standards and regulations. The scope of the training will include a review of quality management systems (QMS) concepts with a specific focus on management leadership, management's role and accountability, the context of the organization, the responsibility of the process owners, business operations performance effectiveness, metrics, and improvement; how the standard provides value-added tools for bottom line results and risk management. Additional discussions include the Registrar's point of view and the implementation of management strategies. The course is conducted by a practicing Registrar Lead Auditor and Business Manager, providing first-hand information; the Registrar's expectations as to what must be in place from a management perspective; how best to prepare for certification, certification upgrade, or to maintain certification status.
